

Report Orplid, Urim Masterclasses 2022-23

Introduction

Over the years Urim Masterclass has presented many prominent singers and pianists associated with the lieder art-form, who have taught masterclasses working closely with voice and piano students from all over the world.

What makes the masterclasses so unique is that only voice-piano duos can apply. One can experience the intimacy and intensity of such a musical partnership by working on this specific repertoire. Working from October through to April culminating in a final festive.

In season Urim Masterclass 2022-23 five duos participated.

The masterclasses took place in Brussels in 'La Monnaie' and in the family house 'Maison Solanet'. The final concert took place in the 'Foyer La Monnaie'.

Artistic director Christianne Stotijn is responsible for the content of the masterclasses. For the organisation she is supported by Leen Van den Borre, production manager. Every year in June voice-piano duos can register for an audition and a jury will accept up to nine duos.
